Directions to UVM's Special Collections:

If driving from I-89 at 14W, travel on Rte 2 (Williston Road) to the third traffic light, past Staples Plaza with the Michael's Craft Store on your left. At that light, which is past the East Avenue light, enter the right hand road that leads to the Hospital and the water tower. Follow the signs to "Visitor Parking" on your left.

From Burlington, get onto Pearl Street heading away from the lake; this becomes Colchester Avenue in front of the Medical Center. From Winooski, get onto Colchester Avenue heading toward Burlington. Driving from either direction, turn onto East Avenue at the light by the India House Restaurant. Follow signs to the hospital Emergency room, turning Right onto Corrigan Drive. Cross the intersection at the light at the top of the hill. Follow the signs to the Visitor Parking on your left.

Parking is free after 3:30 p.m. Park at the visitor's parking at parking meters (between Main Street, the windmill and the water tower). Take the pedestrian walk along Main Street to the Davis Center or walk toward it closer to campus. Pass the center on your left and head down the stairway (past the Rubenstein School for Environmental and Natural Resources.) At the bottom of the stairway, head straight to the Bailey-Howe Library which has a white marble wall, two long rows of windows and a large abstract sculpture out front.

Enter the doors and go down the stairs on your Right. At the foot of the stairs, turn Left to enter the Special Collections.
