ENTRY FEE The entry fee is: \$12 per entry (entry fees contribute towards the cost of exhibit space, hanging, and publicity)

Make checks out to: BOOK ARTS GUILD of VERMONT
All work that needs to be mailed back to the artist must have pre-paid boxes or envelopes and a self-addressed label. Any packing material that needs to be returned with the book art should also be clearly/permanently labeled.

SPECIFICATIONS You may submit up to 3 number of works. All media will be considered as long as it relates to book arts. Each artist is guaranteed one entry for exhibition. All subsequent entries will be exhibited as gallery space allows.

Sized requirements are: 5 X 5 inches or smaller.

All 2-D work must be ready to hang.
All 3-D work must be display within a 12 inch width and 6 inch depth.

LABEL ENTRIES Artists must clearly & firmly **label each submission with title and the artist’s name.**

SALES The Emile A. Gruppe Gallery will receive a 35% commission for any work that is sold while on exhibit.

INSURANCE & LIABILITY While all due care will be taken with the artist’s work, neither the gallery nor the Book Arts Guild will assume any liability for loss or damage however caused. Artists are encouraged to provide their own insurance on artwork in transit and during the exhibition. Submission of artwork constitutes acceptance of these terms.

PICK UP At the end of the exhibit, works will be picked up by a member of the Guild’s Exhibit Committee and brought to the following Guild meeting on June 1st.
