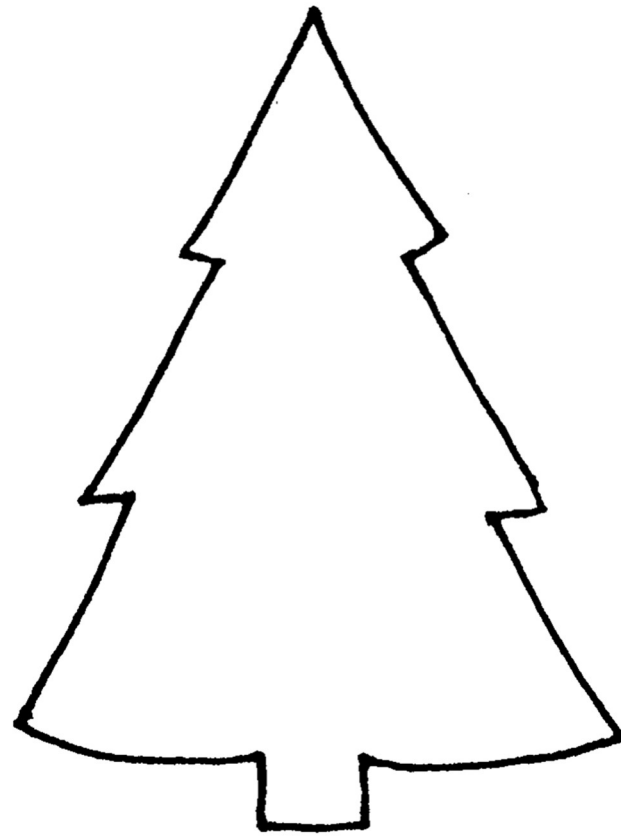
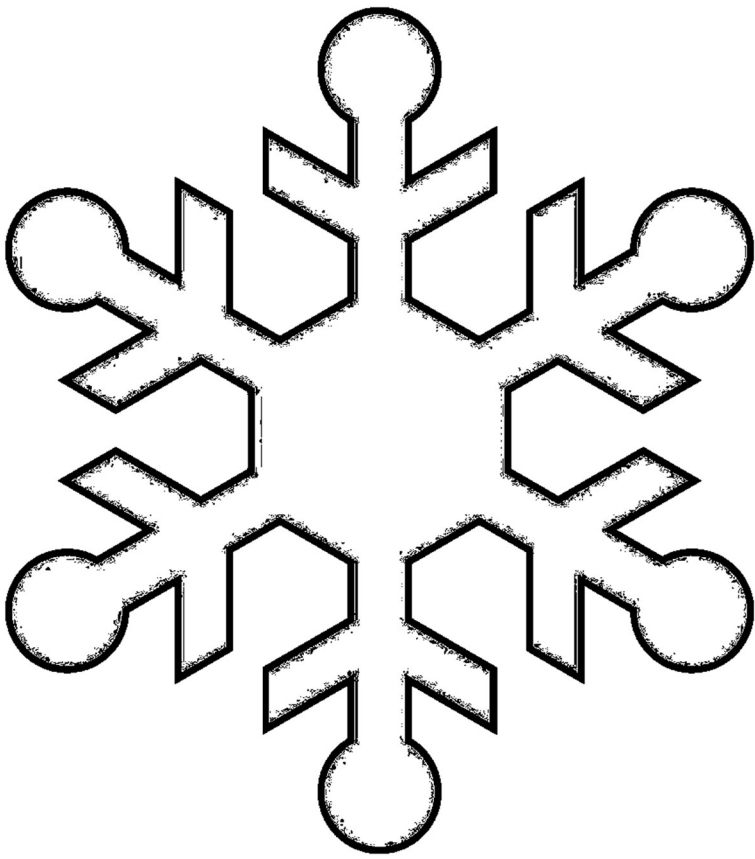


CURVED THEATER CARD

When folded flat, this card fits inside an A-7 envelope.

1. Take a 5" high x 16" wide (grain short) piece of cardstock and score it vertically from the left side at the following measurements: 2.25", 4.5", 11.5", 13.75".
2. Fold on the score lines towards the center of the strip.
3. Cut out an oval in the center panel.
4. Cut out clip art and fold it in half.
5. Lay the clip art on one of the end panels, with the center lined up with the vertical score line. Trace around the clip art. Repeat on the other side of the strip.
6. Cut on the traced lines until the clip art shape has no paper surrounding it (you'll need to trim at the top and bottom).
7. Make a cut on the first vertical score line, from the top edge to the center point. Make a cut on the last vertical score line, from the bottom edge to the center point.
8. Take the two shaped end panels and pull them towards each other. The center panel will start to curve. Tuck the shaped end panels inside the theater and weave them together using the 2 slits you cut.
